BUILDING THE DORMS FOR THE MECHINA IN ELI

Ever since the founding of the mechina 35 years ago, the students have been living in temporary structures.

For the past 30 years, the mechina dorms have been several rows of caravans, which have become quite dilapidated over the decades. The time has come to build respectable and safe dorms for the mechina students. Following a long planning process with Platin Architects and an extensive

team of consultants, Baruch Hashem the construction of the dormitories has begun. The first stage of the campus will have 10 dorm buildings, with a total of 48 rooms, and will house 288 students.

The lower floors are taking shape and rising from the foundations, and we are happy that Nitzav, which is building this project, has appointed Yosef Kashdan, a graduate of Bnei David's Chai Roi program and the School of Engineering at Ariel University, to supervise the work.



FUNDRAISING FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE DORMS

The completion of the campus in Eli and the construction of the dorms will cost a total of NIS 20 million. So for 25% of this sum has been raised, and we are continuing to seek new friends and partners who will assist us in this project.

In early September an evening event was held with representatives of all the past cohorts of the mechina, to brainstorm together for ways to recruit alumni in particular and Jews everywhere in general to the fundraising effort. Several practical ideas were proposed at that evening,

and after the High Holidays we will begin working on them and promoting them in the hope that this entire project can be completed by the beginning of the 2023-24 academic year.

The planning team is closely following the construction work, and is currently busy selecting the finishing materials for the project.

The 7th cohort of young women at Midreshet Danielle concluded a special year of studies at an emotional evening event in Jerusalem, sponsored by Mr. Moti Sonnenfeld, Danielle z"l's father.

Throughout the evening, Moti spoke about his daughter and her special qualities, and Rabbanit Rachel Haber, director of the Gift of Life kidney donation association, spoke to the students about giving and a life of mission, as embodied by her late husband, Rabbi Yeshayahu Haber, z"l. At the end of the evening the graduates gave a special gift to Moti, in honor of the birth of his daughter – a baby outfit with the message, "In 18 years I'll be learning at Midreshet Danielle."



LEARNING AND COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT AT OZ V'EMUNA YESHIVA IN TEL AVIV

Baruch Hashem we have started the academic year with 60 students, 15 of whom are first-year students.

Throughout the month the students have been leading dozens of Selichot tours of the neighborhood. The tour groups come to see the neighborhood and hear its history, and at the end of the tour say the Selichot prayers, each group at a different synagogue. We are grateful to our students and encourage those who are coping with complex



challenges, but whose main focus is still the importance of learning Torah in the neighborhood.
